HERE IS WHAT'S HAPPENING on CAMPUS PROJECTS

- **Anschutz Engineering Center**
 - PD&C staff are working with the general contractor while they complete the remaining punch list corrections. Corrections to site and landscaping work will be done in the spring. Additional corrections include completion of the building commissioning and LEED Gold certification process.
- **Engineering & Applied Science Building Renovation**
 - Construction work is expected to begin in late March. Fences around the building are to be erected shortly. Construction is expected to be completed in 2 phases starting spring term 2026 and run for 2 years. The office swing space to support academic operations in the library through the project duration was opened on schedule and is in use.
- **Columbine Hall Upgrade Controls**
 - The project is complete and currently in final commissioning.
- **University Hall – Nursing Interior Renovation**
 - The project is almost complete. Only one sign remains to be installed.
- **University Hall Boiler Replacement**
 - The project is almost complete. The contractor is completing inspections and punch list items. The boiler is operational and the contractor is completing the controls system.
- **Building Retro-Commissioning**
 - In partnership with Colorado Springs Utilities and their Commercial Building Efficiency Program, eight (8) campus building will be undergoing Retro-Commissioning projects. These buildings include Centennial Hall, Ent Center for the Arts, Gallogly Recreation & Wellness Center, Hybl Sports Medicine and Performance Center, Lane Center, Osborne Center for Science and Engineering, University Center and University Hall.
 - These projects will reduce utility and operational costs, as well as improve indoor air quality and system reliability and operations.
- **Downtown Expansion**
 - This project is in partnership with Norwood Development Group. The timeline for the project will be shared once project scope is finalized.

- **Main Hall Boiler Replacement**
 - The project is almost complete. The contractor is completing inspections and punch list items. Additional scope to upgrade the controls have been approved and that work will start after spring semester.
- **Main Hall AHU Controls Upgrade**
 - This project is being done in coordination with the boiler replacement and will be done during the first few weeks after graduation (May 18th – early June.) Staff and visitors in Main Hall during that time will likely notice temperature changes in the building – either warmer or cooler. It most likely will be warmer than usual. Thank you for being patient while we adjust the building operation.
- **El Pomar Center / Kraemer Family Library Chiller**
 - The project is in construction and is on schedule. The remaining construction work will take place in the penthouse and not affect the balance of the building. After construction the project will be commissioned and we will provide an update once commissioning is scheduled, as this activity will occur in a front-of-house space. Completion of the project is expected by the end of June.
- **El Pomar Center / Kraemer Family Library Controls**
 - The project remains on schedule. The remaining work will take place in the penthouse, with no impacts expected to the overall project timeline. We will provide an update once commissioning is scheduled, as this activity will occur in a front-of-house space.
- **Meadow Lane and Regent Circle Paving**
 - The City of Colorado Springs will be doing a paving project this summer which will include paving of the Meadow Lane and Regent Circle entries and roundabouts. The work will also include improvements to PD&C staff are working with the City to establish
- **Gallogly Recreation and Wellness Center – Aquatic Center replastering and painting**
 - The project is almost complete. The contractor is fixing a few minor spots on the pebble surface of the deck and then the project will be done. The pool is open and it's beautiful.
- **Café 65 Grease Interceptor project**
 - The design builder is under contract and design begins at the end of March.
 - Construction work will take place over the summer.
